a,b,c	Indicates a rotated token	If there are 3 or fewer known angles of rotation for a specific token each rotated token will have a different extension letter. If there are more than 3 angles, only the "a" extension will be
e,f,g	Indicates a cracked Die	If there are 3 or fewer die cracks for a specific token each token will have a different extension letter. For more than 3 cracks, only the "e" extension will be used and the crack locations will
w,x, y or z	Indicates a special token that is solid, clad or plated by a precious metal such as gold or silver

Rotation

1:00, 2:00	Position on a clock face
R	Multiple angles of rotation. Used if more than 3 different angles of rotation are found.
Blank	No detectable rotation or a rotation of less than 5° (about one minute on clock face)

Year

1965, 1980, etc.	The year that is stamped on the token. This is for identification purposes only and does not necessarily indicate the year the token was approved, minted or issued.
(1965), (1980), (etc.)	Parentheses () indicate that the year is not on the token but the token was either minted or issued on or around the year indicated. This is shown for information purposes only and may not be 100% accurate. Enter year as a negative number e.g. -1990.
ND	Indicates that the year is not stamped on the token and the issue date is unknown.

Face Value

Parentheses (\$1.00) indicate that the face value is not on the token.
