

Please bid by lot number. Format: Lot #, Description, Reference #, Minimum Reserve (if any). Additionally, grades for items will be noted after the reserve, with + equating to a better example of an item, = equating to an average example of an item, and – meaning this is of a lesser quality, with major defects noted after the description. This may be your last list! Due to the ever-increasing price of publication, production, and postage, if you do not submit a winning bid or do not receive our fixed price list on a normal basis, this will be your last list. Cost of any new mail bid sale will be **\$2.00 each** to defray our cost. An **X** next to your name on the mailing label indicates that this is your last list with out either a winning bid or \$10.00.

Terms of Sale:

1. Lots to the highest bidder. Lots with a reserve will have the highest bid reduced to 10% over second highest bids when possible **UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 50%**. Bids without a reserve will **NOT** have highest bid reduced.
2. Reserve/Minimum Bids, if any, will be listed after the lot description.
3. Bids will be entered as they are received. In case of a tie bid, the earliest bid will prevail.
4. Telephone bids are welcomed; however a written bid must be on file in advance of your telephone call. If you inquire about a high bid, you must offer a bid of 10% higher than the highest bid. A call back service is provided if your bid is surpassed by another, but you must indicate this on your bid form. Callbacks are billed at \$1.00 per call.
5. ***There is a 10% buyer's fee.*** We do add postal charges at cost and offer optional insurance on U.S. Orders only.
6. Prices realized sent free of charge to all bidders. Non-bidders may purchase a copy for \$2.00.
7. This is not an approval sale. You may return lots because of an error in the listing or if token is improperly graded. **You must return tokens within 5 business days of receipt.**
8. **Invoices are due upon receipt.** Please arrange for credit payment and terms in advance.
9. Now accepting consignments of tokens for our next mail bid sale.
10. Bids under \$1.00 will not be accepted.
11. Illustrations are not actual size.

In most cases, tokens are round unless other wise noted either in the mail bid or the reference material used. We use Curto, Cunningham, and Bows numbers as well as numbers from our own published reference guides. Most of these reference materials are available from a number of sources including us. Items not listed in these books will either not have a reference number listed, or if the item falls within an established numbering system, we will assign a logical number to that item. Chits are craft colored unless otherwise noted. If you have questions concerning a lot, please call or write for additional details. If you are unsure that you desire a lot, then do not bid on it unless you are willing to keep your mistakes.
